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Every Post, regardless of size and regardless of location, is asked to name a "Scout of the Year" in their community. A Post does not have to have a school, nor does it need to have a scout troop or den, etc. in its community. It just needs to have one young person participating in scouting at some level who the Posts feels should be recognized as the Scout of the Year in their community.

If a Post's community does not have anyone in scouting they may select someone in 4-H or some other community service or religious activity, or simply a "Young Citizen of The Year".

Once the Post's selection is made complete and mail the form on the back of this flyer to Department Headquarters. Headquarters then will mail a certificate tailored to the recipient and their activity. The Post is then asked to present the award at an appropriate time and place.

The Post is asked to enter the activity on Post Activity Tracking" form provided to every Post Adjutant in their "Post Adjutant's Packet provided to them each June. Then the Post is expected to include the activity on their Children & Youth report which is due at their District Convention.
